Brush Pickup 2016 April – November

The North Baltimore Brush Pick-Up Program is for weather related and trimmed brush, **from a North Baltimore resident's property only.** Brush from a contracted tree removal/trimming project on a resident's property will be the responsibility of the property owner. Please include removal and clean up in your contract. It is unfair to ask the tax payers of the Village to help cover this cost.

To better serve all residents, brush piles that are particularly large and require more than 1 hour to remove will be partially removed, allowing time for brush to be picked up at other residences. DPW staff will revisit large piles for complete removal. To help us plan ahead for large brush pile removal, contact the Village Office to provide the location. Please only report large brush piles.

This is a curbside pickup of brush up to 6" in diameter. **Piles must be neatly stacked with cut ends curb side, with no lawn waste or thorns and placed out by 7:00 a.m. on pickup days.**

2016 BRUSH PICKUP SCHEDULE

1st full two weeks of April - April 4th to April 15th

1st full week of May - May 2th to May 6th

1st Monday thereafter: June - November

- If Monday is a Holiday, brush will be picked up on the Tuesday following the Holiday.
- If inclement weather on 1st Monday, brush will be picked up the following day.

Leaf Pickup will be mid-October – mid-December

- Please place leaves in clear bags at curbside for pick up.
- The village will supply you with **TEN FREE BAGS** per address.
- The bags may be picked up at the village office. You may purchase additional bags, at five bags per dollar.
- **PLEASE DO NOT** rake leaves or grass into the street. This will cause the street sweeper to plug up, sewer drains to clog, and cause flooding

Village wide trash pickup

- This trash pickup is for one day only. It will be June 20th.

Street Sweeping will occur April - November

1st and 3rd Tues. of each month from Main St. – West.

1st and 3rd Thurs. of each month from Main St. – East.

Street sweeping will be completed as needed in addition to the schedule above. Please park off the street during these dates.

Christmas tree pickup will be Jan 2ND 2017 – Jan 10th 2017.

Place unwanted trees at curbside (not bagged) for pickup.

Snow Removal: Please remove cars from street after 2 inches of snow or more. DO NOT shovel, blow, or plow snow into the street.

Street Lighting: if you see a street light not working please get ID number from pole and report to 419-257-2394.

Cemetery Clean Up will be April 1st and November 1st.

A copy of cemetery rules is available at the village office.

Village Park opens April 1st – December 1st.

Park hours are 6am until 11pm. Restrooms and water will be available May – November, or until the last home football game.

See the village office for shelter house rental. Rental fee is 40.00 with 10.00 refunded when key is returned.

Hydrant Flushing will be in the month of May and October.

Residents may experience rusty water during this time. Please use caution when using water for laundry. Should you do laundry during this hydrant flushing and rust appears on clothing, rust remover is available at the village office **free of charge**.

The water will be safe to drink.
